



CORONAVIRUS UPDATE: June 17, 2020

Coronavirus & Our Market Square Response

- Because of safety protocols surrounding the COVID-19 pandemic and ongoing construction in the sanctuary this summer, the session at its June 16 meeting has indicated there will be no Sunday morning in-person worship through the end of September. If current construction schedules hold, we anticipate that World Communion Sunday will be our return date with appropriate safety protocols in place. (With COVID-19 safety protocols in effect, neither Geneva Hall or the Chapel will provide sufficient social distancing space in order to hold worship in either of those spaces, so live worship will continue to be broadcast on Sunday mornings via radio stations 960AM or 102.9FM or via the radio button on our church website – www.marketsquarechurch.org.)
- With Dauphin County going into the “green phase” this Friday, some small in-person gatherings may be permissible at the church building with the following provisos: arrangements are made with Nancy Sheets at least 48 hours before the requested meeting time who then will confer with Bob Garrett, our Pandemic Safety Officer. If he determines that the meeting can be held with appropriate safety protocols in effect - safe distancing, masks, etc. - Nancy will confirm with the person making the request that the meeting may be held.
